DAY ONE SATURDAY 14TH SEPTEMBER 2024

Arrive into Heathrow Airport where you will be warmly welcomed by your dedicated Driver who will assist you with your luggage and escort you to your transportation. Travel approximately 2 hours 40 minutes to Sandwich and check into the Bell Hotel for your first 3 nights' accommodation.

DAY TWO

SUNDAY 15TH SEPTEMBER 2024

Today you will travel to Royal Cinque Ports or Deal, as it is more commonly known. Lying along a continuous dune in a narrow strip of land between the English Channel and farm grazing land, this course runs out along the seashore and returns inland on a parallel strip to its starting point in a traditional links layout. Deal has hosted the Open Championship in 1909 and 1920 and was to have done again in 1949 until the sea flooded the course. Please note this course has reciprocal playing rights with Royal Auckland & Grange GC and as such you should arrange this round directly with the club. Course: Royal Cinque Ports

DAY THREE

MONDAY 16TH SEPTEMBER 2024

Today play a round on Royal St George's, the sixth oldest club in the world. A links course full of awkward twists and turns each designed to derail an overconfident approach. Founded in 1887 and intended by its founder, Dr William Laidlaw Purves, to be a rival to St Andrews in the South of England, St George's is consistently ranked amongst the leading courses in the World. The Club occupies a unique place in the history of golf, for it was here in 1894, that the Open Championship

was first played outside Scotland. In all there have been 14 Open Championships played at St George's, more than any course outside of Scotland. The Open Championship returned to St George's for the 15th time in 2021, when the Club hosted the 149th Open Championship.

DAY FOUR

TUESDAY 17TH SEPTEMBER 2024

Check out of the Bell Hotel and transfer to Windsor. Drive time is approximately 2 hours 40 minutes.

No golf is scheduled for today so you could visit the famous cathedral city of Canterbury. Situated in one of the most attractive corners of rural Kent and has been welcoming visitors for over 2000 years. Canterbury today is a delightful mixture of architecture, history, arts and culture, museums, shops of every description, visitor attractions and good restaurants and pubs. Check into Sir Christopher Wren's House Hotel in Windsor for the next 7 nights.

DAY FIVE

WEDNESDAY 18TH SEPTEMBER 2024

Today play Sunningdale's New Course. The New Course opened in 1923 and was designed by Harry Colt to meet the increasing demand for golf following the end of the First World War. Not so heavily bunkered or tree lined as the Old, but with more heather, longer carries, and tighter fairways gives exhilarating views across the wild landscape of Chobham Common.

Course: Sunningdale New

Accommodation: Sir Christopher Wren Hotel, Windsor



DAY SIX THURSDAY 19TH SEPTEMBER 2024

Travel approximately 20 minutes to Swinley Forest today. One of the finest examples of heathland golf with a very impressive array of par 3s. Designed by Harry Colt and opened in 1909, Swinley Forest places exact demands on the highest skilled golfer, yet remains enjoyable to those less skilled. An exclusive members club Swinley has a unique charm and ambience.

Course: Swinley Forest GC

Accommodation: Sir Christopher Wren Hotel, Windsor

DAY SEVEN

FRIDAY 20TH SEPTEMBER 2024

Play St Georges Hill this morning. Another course designed by the legendary Harry Colt and opened in 1913. Each hole, of which there are three loops of nine, is memorable and individual in character, lined with heather and elegant Scots pine, the fairways are undulating and follow the natural contours of the land. An enjoyable course in quiet surroundings.

Accommodation: Sir Christopher Wren Hotel, Windsor

DAY EIGHT SATURDAY 21ST SEPTEMBER 2024

Today is at your leisure to explore London. London has the greatest concentration of major attractions in Britain and offers an amazing variety of places to visit. One of the best ways to view the city is to take an Open Top Bus Tour allowing you to visit your selected attraction and make as many stops on each route as you wish. The City Sightseeing Tour is highly recommended for overseas visitors. It covers the best of London's sights with an informative commentary in a choice of languages. DAY TEN

MONDAY 23RD SEPTEMBER 2024

Play Sunningdale Old today. Opened in 1901, this delightful course was laid out by Willie Park Jnr. Virtually every hole is played in splendid isolation, and in harmony with nature. Arguably the most beloved exclusive inland courses in the British Isles. Course: Sunningdale (Old Course)

Accommodation: Sir Christopher Wren Hotel, Windsor

DAY ELEVEN TUESDAY 24TH SEPTEMBER 2024

Check out of your accommodation in Windsor and travel north to Southport. Drive time is approximately 4 hours. On route you can stop at Blenheim Palace. Upon arrival at Southport, check into the Vincent Hotel for 7 nights.

DAY TWELVE

WEDNESDAY 25TH SEPTEMBER 2024

Travel the short distance (approx 10 minutes) to play Hillside. Situated next door to Royal Birkdale, Hillside is widely regarded as the best links never to have hosted the Open Championship. The links provides a variety of holes in a majestic setting that will test the best players. The course is well known for its wonderful conditioning with very slick greens. The back nine holes are amongst the best in Britain.

Course: Hillside GC

Accommodation: The Vincent-Southport

DAY THIRTEEN THURSDAY 26TH SEPTEMBER 2024

Play Royal Birkdale today. A course that provides a formidable test of links golf and fully deserves its recognition as a true venue for the Open Championship. Each hole runs in valleys between towering sandhills. The problems are clearly stated, if you stray from the fairway the buckthorn and scrub can be demanding. Consistently ranked as one of the best courses in the British Isles and the #1 in England.

Course: Royal Birkdale

Accommodation: The Vincent -Southport

DAY FOURTEEN FRIDAY 27TH SEPTEMBER 2024

Travel approximately 1 hour 15 minutes south to the Wirral for a round on Royal Liverpool. Despite its somewhat flat and benign appearance, Royal Liverpool is among the toughest and most demanding of the great seaside championship links of Britain. Hoylake, as it is more commonly known, lies at the very heart of the history and development of golf in Britain. Built in 1869, on what was then the racecourse of the Liverpool Hunt Club, Hoylake is one of the oldest English seaside courses and regular host venue for The Open.

DAY FIFTEEN SATURDAY 28TH SEPTEMBER 2024

Travel approximately 20 minutes to play Formby today. A beautiful links, lying within the sandhills and pinewoods of Formby. The club has a distinguished record of staging many major Amateur events including the British Amateur Championship on four occasions. In 2004, Formby hosted the Curtis Cup when Michelle Wie competed for the US Team.

Course: Formby GC Accommodation: The Vincent-Southport

DAY SIXTEEN

SUNDAY 29TH SEPTEMBER 2024

Today is at your leisure for some sightseeing. Enjoy a visit to Chester, one of the finest heritage cities in the world, with the most complete city walls in Britain. Explore the exciting history of Chester with a walking tour through the unique half-timbered galleried streets and enjoy the splendor of the black and white buildings. Accommodation: The Vincent-Southport

DAY SEVENTEEN MONDAY 30TH SEPTEMBER 2024

Travel approximately 1 hour north to play Lytham and St Annes today. Arguably the toughest of England's championship links courses. Unusual for a British links it does not sit beside the sea. It's main defence is the vast numbers of deep bunkers guarding both the fairways as well as the greens. It enjoys a very special atmosphere. It was here in 1926 that Bobby Jones won the British Open Championship, his legendary shot to the 17th green is commemorated by a plaque. Course: Royal Lytham & St Annes GC Accommodation: The Vincent

DAY EIGHTEEN TUESDAY 1ST OCTOBER 2024

Check out of your accommodation in Southport. The group will be collected by a Driver and transferred approximately 1 hour to Manchester Airport for your departure flight. Farewell to England!


